The Academy offers members its services in promoting the recognition of authors' works through careful selection and the organization of events of great public interest such as the Italia Prize (for poetry, fiction and non-fiction). In addition, the Academy continues to provide a whole range of information and organizational services to help authors.

As part of its services in 1982, the Academy has undertaken to print and supply free of charge to each member author 500 copies of a personal four-page brochure, containing biographical information about the author and critical reviews where appropriate, as in the enclosed specimen. All you have to do to receive the 500 printed copies within 45 days is to send us the material for publication. The aim of the personal brochure, apart from establishing the member's credentials with the Academy, is to provide a practical means of widespread communication with both the general public and specialised interests (e.g. magazines, newspapers and publishers).

The 1982 membership fee has been fixed by the Assembly at US \$ 90/ £ 45/.

We invite you, therefore, to send us your application for 1982 membership, in order to take advantage of all the aforementioned services, and the material to be printed in your personal brochure.
