At the Villa Rose. By A. E. W. MASON. 1 vol. - 4210.

The clever French detective who is the salient personality in Mr. Mason's new book will rank as a competitor of Sir A. Conan Doyle's "Sherlock Holmes." The mystery is cunningly elaborated, and holds the reader spellbound to the finish.
