Section 1. Purpose of the Act
The purpose of this Act is to provide for the better regulation and control of the practice of medicine and surgery in the United States, and to protect the public health and safety.

Section 2. Definitions
In this Act, the following definitions shall apply: (a) "Physician" means a person who is duly licensed to practice medicine and surgery in any State or Territory of the United States.

Section 3. Enforcement
The Secretary of Agriculture shall have the duty to enforce the provisions of this Act, and to issue such orders and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.
